It is with regret that we inform you of the sudden death on, Sunday 16th December, of the **Reverend Alyn Owens**, a retired minister living in Chippenham.

Alyn served at Eccleston, St Helens 1963-67; Wycliffe, Leicester 1967-69; Halesworth 1969-75; Doddridge Memorial, Northampton 1975-79; Abbey Road, Torquay, Marldon & Babbacombe 1979-82; St Mark's, Mount Pleasant 1982-87; & Rye 1982-88; St Luke's, Silverhill 1992-94; St Andrew's, Eastcote 1994-2003; and was very active as a hospital chaplain in retirement.

- Working with the Property Officer to take the lead in transactions relating to land and property


