One of the things I enjoy, when I have the time, is to go bird watching and when I go away on holiday I usually find the time to visit a nature reserve. Increasingly I have become aware of how seriously some people take this. Modern technology means that within minutes of a rare bird being seen, the information is shared via the internet and pagers and often hides empty quickly as people head off in search of the latest rarity. The quality and cost of cameras, telescopes and binoculars continues to escalate, each often in excess of £2,000. Distances seem to matter little to the serious twitcher as rarities often crop up in one of our off-shore islands and charter boats and aircraft are often used in the search for a new tick in their list of birds seen in the year, or even better, for the first time in their lifetime.

Among the serious birdwatchers there's a longing to see something new, with time and money being no problem. And then, I think of the Church, is the Church longing to see something new, or is it far more comfortable with what it knows? Are cost and distance no problem? In the words of the song, "The times, they are a changing." Change in the Church can be uncomfortable, many of our churches today are unrecognisable compared to what our grandparents were used to. Today we need to look to the future and accept that some changes are inevitable, but that can be exciting, just as seeing a rare bird for the first time.

#### **RETIRED MINISTERS' HOUSING FUND**

This Fund is available to assist Retired Ministers with their housing costs. The Fund arose from the Will of Rev. Helen Matheson, a non stipendiary Minister, and the purpose of the Fund is "to provide small improvements to accommodation occupied by retired Ministers. It does not matter whether the property is rented or owned by the Minister. Small improvements might include installation of a shower, additional electrical outlets, professional decorating, improvements or repairs to heating, cooking or laundry services or outside work to reduce the labour involved in garden maintenance, replacement of fences or anything else that would be of benefit. The Fund is administered in the Synod Office and grants are payable only if application is made and approval given before the work is commenced. Jane Wade, Minister at Abington Avenue and Paulerspury URC's is hoping to lead a party to the Holy Land. If you are interested and would like to see a sample programme please get in touch with Jane.

It is always very moving to make a pilgrimage to the Holy Land, there is so much to see and experience and learn together. St Jerome said: 'Five gospels record the life of Jesus. Four you will find in books and the one you will find in the land they call Holy. Read the fifth gospel and the world of the four will open to you. We invite you to come and know this for yourselves whether you are new to the Holy Land or have been many times before; there are always new sights and sounds to reflect upon. Reading the gospels will never be the same again and by visiting the Holy Land we are standing in solidarity with our brothers and sisters there too. To have the chance to meet the 'living stones', the local Palestinian and Israeli Christians who are the ongoing, living church in the region, is humbling.

Our pilgrimage will include the sites where the most important events in Our Lord's life and ministry took place: in Jerusalem and the surrounding area and further north in Galilee. We hope that if you have never been on pilgrimage to the Holy Land before you will choose to join us and, if you have been before, we welcome you back. Our journey is a life changing as well as faith changing experience.

The cost would be £1,675 per person sharing a twin/double room and includes everything as stated in the programme - but is based on a on a minimum group size of 15.


